**Refunds:** No refunds will be given, except for injury or family move from the area. In case of a financial hardship, please contact the League President.

**Uniforms:** All players will keep the League-provided team and practice jerseys. We recommend girls in the MAJORS and SENIORS Divisions wear black shorts/pants, which can be purchased at the Varsity Shop in Birmingham. We strongly recommend that players wear sliding shorts under their shorts/pants or a sliding pad on their knee to reduce injury. We also encourage the use of fielding masks or mouth guards for the player's own protection.

**MINOR Division Team Selection:** Our Minor Division accommodates girls in 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> grades. We <u>try to</u> the best of our abilities to select teams based on the **school the player attends** as well as specific requests to play with friends.

**Player Evaluations for MAJORS and SENIORS Divisions:** All players are required to attend one of two evaluation sessions (pick the one most convenient for you). Coaches will assess each player's skill level in preparation for the league draft, which attempts to balance the teams with comparable talent; for this reason, MAJORS and SENIORS Division players may not request to play with their friends. Only familial accommodations will be made. All players who register AND attend one of the two evaluation sessions will be drafted.
